

**Project:** *Proposed K-12 School - Willard, Ohio*

*Traffic Impact Study*

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**Description:** TMS Engineers, Inc. has prepared Traffic Impact Study for a proposed redevelopment of the existing Willard middle and high school site in Willard, Huron County, Ohio. The project site is bordered by Main Street (State Route 103) to the west, Myrtle Avenue to the east, Walton Street (US Route 224) to the south, and Whisler Drive to the north.

The site is currently occupied by the Willard middle school and high school as well as related school facilities such as the bus garage and athletic fields. The redevelopment of the site is proposed to include the development of a new kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade school that would accommodate 831 elementary school students, 387 middle school students, and 461 high school students.

Based upon the results of the analysis in this study, it can be seen that with the recommended access scheme, the development traffic can be accommodated without significantly impacting the area roadway network under the AM and PM peak hour conditions.
